1 Raffle Name

4 Relevant State(s)

Permitted

Entry is open to residents of Queensland only aged 18 years or older at the commencement of the Raffle.

5 Raffle Period

The Promotion starts at 5pm AEST on Monday 19th June, 2023.

The Promotion closes at 11:59pm AEST on Wednesday, 2 August 2023, or until all tickets are sold. No entries will be accepted after this time.

8 Maximum Number of Entries

10 Verification Requirements
