

## **Child Cancer Research Foundation Terms and Conditions for Father's Day Raffle 2023**

### **1. Child Cancer Research Foundation (CCRF) Raffle and Prize**

a) Child Cancer Research Foundation (CCRF) Father's Day Typhoon Tools Raffle is conducted as a Standard Lottery under the Western Australian Gaming and Wagering Commission.

b) First Prize is a Typhoon Toolset and Typhoon Toolbox worth AU\$ 1300.

\*The value in the case of the prize will be the retail value according to the supplier of the prize.

### **2. Tickets**

- A maximum number of 500 tickets will be sold at AU\$5 each
- Tickets are available for purchase online only.
- All ticket purchases require immediate payment.
- Tickets will be issued upon receipt of payment.
- Tickets cannot be purchased for the Foundation on behalf of any member or organiser.
- Members/ staff may purchase tickets for personal use.

### **3. Closing Date, Draw and Notification**

- The close date is 4 pm (AWT), 31 August 2023.
- Online sales will cease at 3.59 pm on Thursday, 31 August.
- The draw date is 4 pm (AWT), 31 August 2023. This will be a random digital draw using the built-in RaffleTix draw system conducted at the Child Cancer Research Foundation office at 3/100 Hay Street Subiaco, WA 6008.
- If CCRF decides that an insufficient number of tickets will be sold by the closing date, the closing date and the drawing date may both be extended (with the required approvals from the relevant regulators) such that the drawing date is not later than one (1) year after the day tickets in the raffle start to be sold.
- The raffle results will be published on the CCRF website, [childcancerresearch.com.au](http://childcancerresearch.com.au), on the date specified (unless extended) in the tickets detailing the prize won, the prize winner's name and the winning ticket number.
- CCRF will make all reasonable efforts in accordance with the WA Gaming Act to notify the winner by telephone and/or registered mail.
- If a prize winner does not claim their prize within 30 days of the draw, then the prize will be deemed abandoned and entitlement to the prize, if by then having been purchased by the Child Cancer Research Foundation (CCRF), will remain with CCRF, but if not so purchased, CCRF will be under no obligation to do so. CCRF is not liable to conduct a redraw for any prize that is not claimed by a prize winner within twelve (12) months of the draw.

### **4. Other**

- Any other expenses, including but not limited to transport and additional costs involved in the collection of the prize (other than when specifically included in the prize) are at the winner's sole expense.
- The prize offered may NOT be substituted for cash.
