1 Raffle Name

5 Raffle Period

7 Maximum Number of Tickets

25,000 tickets available for purchase. The following ticket pricing bundles are offered:

The Raffle will close at the end of the Promotion Period or when all tickets are sold, whichever comes first.

8 Maximum Number of Entries

No maximum applies. Participants may purchase as many tickets as they like while the Raffle remains open, and tickets are available.

9 Entry Restrictions

Entry is open to residents of the **Relevant State(s)** aged 18 years or older at the commencement of the Raffle.

The following people are not eligible to enter and are not eligible for any prizes:

- Directors, employees, and contractors of the Promoter (Burrinja), Dandenong Ranges Community Finance Ltd, and RaffleTix;
- Any other person directly engaged in managing the organisation of the raffle or conducting the draw; or
- Any immediate family members of any of the above. "Immediate family member" means any of the following: spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether by natural or by adoption.)



10 Verification Requirements

If requested by the Promoter, a person drawn as the winner of a prize must produce proof of age and residency prior to being awarded a prize. If they do not do this promptly to the reasonable satisfaction of the Promoter, the Promoter may redraw the prize subject to the relevant regulatory approvals, in which case that person forfeits any right to claim the prize.

16 Unclaimed Prize Arrangements

If a Prize is not claimed by the Prize Claim Date or is deemed invalid in accordance with the Entry Restrictions, the Promoter reserves the right (subject to regulatory approval, if required) to sell that prize. Proceeds from such sales will be paid to the Promoter who will distribute sale proceeds to the not-for-profit Community Group that has sold the most tickets.

17 Additional Terms – Privacy

The Promoter and its authorised marketing partners reserve the right to send marketing communications to any entrant that opts-in to receive communications from the Promoter and its authorised marketing partners. The entrant can advise the Promoter at any time if they no longer wish to receive this information, by contacting the Promoter's Privacy Officer at (communityraffle@drcbg.com.au). The Promoter and its authorised marketing partners may continue to send communications to the entrant for an indefinite period unless and until advised otherwise by the entrant.

18 Ticket Sellers Eligibility Criteria

The Promoter will invite other not-for-profit community groups ("Ticket Sellers") to sell tickets in the raffle.

To be eligible to become a Ticket Seller, the community club or group must be a not-for-profit organisation, be a customer of one of either Community Bank Upwey, Belgrave or Cockatoo-Gembrook, and be registered with the Promoter.

Ticket Sellers will receive 100% of the proceeds of any ticket sales they generate as a result of their promotional efforts. The Promoter will remit the corresponding funds to the Ticket Seller at the conclusion of the raffle.

In the event a transaction is not attributed to one of the registered Ticket Sellers, it will become part of the "Anonymous Pool". The profits from the Anonymous Pool will be allocated to The Promoter (Burrinja).
