5 Raffle Period

The Promotion starts at 9:00am AEST on Saturday, 1 July 2023.

The Promotion closes at 2:00pm AEST on Saturday 16 September 2023. No entries will be accepted after this time.

8 Maximum Number of Entries

9 Entry Restrictions

Entry is open to residents of Australia aged 18 years or older at the commencement of the Raffle.

Directors, management, employees, contactors of the National Police Memorial and related entities, including any of the Promoter's agents and including RaffleTix, directly involved in the organisation of the Raffle (as determined by the Promoter) are not eligible to enter.

10 Verification Requirements
