1 Raffle Name

2 Promoter

The benefiting organisations are Queensland Ornithological Society trading as Birds Queensland and BirdLife Australia - BirdLife Southern Queensland branch, both not-for-profit organisations. The proceeds will be divided equally.

9 Entry Restrictions

Tickets cannot be purchased by any individual involved in the organisation of the raffle or the draw (including RaffleTix). In addition, tickets cannot be purchased by the association conducting or benefiting from the raffle, or its Management Committee including immediate family members*.

*Immediate family means a person's spouse and family members residing at the same premises as the person

10 Verification Requirements

If requested by the Promoter, a person drawn as the winner of a prize must produce proof of age and residency prior to being awarded a prize. If they do not do this promptly to the reasonable satisfaction of the Promoter, the Promoter may redraw the prize subject to the relevant regulatory approvals, in which case that person forfeits any right to claim the prize.
